

LAND ASSETS

The Parish Council owns the roughly triangular piece of land, approximately 0.25 acres, in the centre of the village comprising the Village Green and adjacent gravelled area – outlined in red on the map below. The Minstead War Memorial stands at the West corner. The Green is sometimes used for community events e.g. the Village Fete, and the gravelled area provides customer parking outside the Village Shop. The land is unfenced and provides grazing to Forest livestock. It was donated to the Parish in 1948.
