Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

- 1. Tackling car crime in the forest car parks
- 2. Reducing vehicle speed in the local villages and within the forest

Total incidents reported: 69, 21 of which were crimes

The other reported incidents related to information messages, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

Anti-social behaviour – (5) There were two reports of poor parking in Cadnam and one in Fritham. Six people were stopped riding a motorcycle on Copythorne Common and a S59 RTA warning was issued. There was a report of residents being excessively noisy at a hotel in Ower.

Assaults - (2) Both took place at local hospitals.

Burglary – (3) There were burglaries at addresses in Cadnam, Bartley and Winsor. *Please report any suspicious people you see day and night.*

Burglary (non dwelling) – (1) A convenience store was broken into and money stolen. *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

Criminal Damage – (3) Two cars were damaged in Newbridge and Winsor and a door was damaged at a fast food restaurant.

Road traffic collisions – (11) Two involved animals; no persons were seriously injured.

Road traffic incidents – Five people were summonsed to court for speeding offences. A male was charged with driving on the B3078.

Theft – (5) Items were stolen from a grave in Copythorne. A wallet was taken at a local hospital, and oil was stolen from a domestic tank in Minstead. Money was taken from a lost purse that was later recovered in Cadnam and items were taken following a domestic dispute in Cadnam.

Theft from vehicles – (3) Two catalytic converters were taken from commercial vehicles in Minstead, a purse was stolen from a vehicle parked at a pub in Ower and a vehicle was broken into in Bramshaw. *Please ensure you secure your vehicle and remove all valuables*.

Other incidents – There were two arson incidents at small holdings in Newbridge and Ower, investigations are ongoing. A number of suspicious vehicle and people have been reported in the last month. *Please continue to be vigilant and report these incidents.*
