Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

1. Tackling car crime in the New Forest car parks
2. Reducing vehicle speed in the local villages and within the New Forest

Total incidents reported: 43, 18 of which were crimes

The other reported incidents related to information messages, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

Anti-social behaviour – (0)

Assaults – (1) This took place at a local hospital.

Burglary – (1) There was an attempted burglary at an address in Bartley and enquiries are on going. *Please report any suspicious people you see day and night.*

Burglary (non dwelling) – (3) Power tools were taken from a shed in Bartley, stables were entered in Newbridge and tools were taken from a local golf course. *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

Criminal Damage – (2) A car window was damaged in Bartley and an incident took place at a local hospital.

Road traffic collisions – (5) Three involved animals, no people were seriously injured.

Road traffic incidents – Three people were summonsed to court for speeding offences. A male was dealt with for document offences in Bartley.

Theft – (3) Around 400 litres of oil was stolen in Tatchbury and in separate incidents a trailer and tools were stolen in Ower.

Theft from vehicles – (5) Five vehicles were broken into in Fritham. Possessions were taken from four cars left in Forest car parks and fuel was removed from a vehicle outside a residential address. *Please ensure you secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*

Other incidents – A number of suspicious vehicles and people have been reported in the last month. *Please continue to be vigilant and report these incidents.*

Speed watch – A total of 242 vehicles were checked by Speed watch volunteers in January. Of those, 133 (55%) motorists were recorded exceeding the speed limit. Please get in touch with us if you would like further details regarding the recorded data and the action taken by police.
