### Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

Our current priorities are tackling crime and anti-social behaviour

#### Total incidents reported: 68, 24 of which were crimes

The other reported incidents related to information messages, suspicious incidents, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

Anti-social behaviour - (5) There were four complaints about nuisance vehicles and a noise complaint.

Assaults - (10) Seven occurred at a local hospital. There were three other assaults, two being domestic related.

Burglary – (0) With the lighter evenings be careful when leaving windows and doors open and please report any suspicious people you see.

Burglary (non dwelling) - (0) Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured and contact local officers if you would like security and prevention advice.

Criminal Damage – (1) A garden gate was damaged by unknown persons.

Road traffic collisions - (6) One involved a horse in Fritham; there was a damage only collision in Newbridge, two in Ower and two on the M27/A31.

Road traffic incidents – Six people were summonsed for speeding offences, four in Bramshaw and two in Cadnam. A driver was also given a penalty notice in Cadnam for not wearing a seatbelt.

Theft – (8) Two involved thefts from electricity poles, five occurred at commercial premise and items were stolen from outside an address in Winsor.

Theft from vehicles - (3) Three vehicles were broken into in a Forest car park. Please ensure you secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.

#### Other events -

Between 1<sup>st</sup> November 2013 and 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014 681 drivers have been dealt with for speeding offence on the beat. From today you can access up to date data. **Speed watch** – A total of 825 vehicles were checked by Speed watch volunteers in August. Of those, 478 (57.9%) motorists were recorded exceeding the speed limit.
