Safer Neighbourhoods team current priorities:

Our team priorities are set by our communities. We target the issues that you say are of concern to you and we work with colleagues and partner agencies to tackle local problems.

Our current priorities are tackling crime and anti-social behaviour

Total incidents reported: 82, 23 of which were crimes

The other reported incidents related to information messages, suspicious incidents, driving complaints and other non-crime matters.

Anti-social behaviour – (6) There were two noise complaints, three incidents involving neighbours and a dispute over property.

Assaults - (4) All occurred at local homes.

Burglary – (0) Please report any suspicious people or vehicles you see day and night.

Burglary (non dwelling) – (5) Outbuildings were broken into in Bramshaw, Cadnam, Ower and two in Copythorne. *Please ensure outbuildings are locked and secured.*

Criminal Damage – (2) An animal was injured in Bramshaw and there was an incident at a local home.

Drugs - (0)

Public Order – (1) There was a dispute over driving in Bramshaw.

Road traffic collisions – (4) There were two minor injury and one non-injury collisions on the A337 and a damage incident in Ower.

Road traffic incidents – Four people were summonsed for speeding offences, one in Bramshaw and three in Cadnam. A driver was charged with driving whilst being unfit through drugs in Ower and two untaxed vehicles were also seized in Ower.

Theft – (4) An animal was stolen in Fritham, there were three commercial thefts at Ower, Bramshaw and Minstead.

Theft from vehicles – (4) Four vehicles were broken into in Forest car parks. *Please ensure you secure your vehicle and remove all valuables.*

Other incidents - Plant equipment was stolen in Ower.
