

LYNDHURST ROAD, MINSTEAD DRAINAGE WORKS

For those who have not already been informed the works which started on 6 June 2016 are expected to last for 5 weeks, during which time Lyndhurst Road will be closed 24/7.

The works will be in three phases:

Phase 1 will be closure of Lyndhurst Road from Shovel Cottage to Old Post Office Road. Access to and from the A31 via the junction by the SSEB at the top end of Lyndhurst Road will not be possible. Access via the lower entrance from the A31, Old Post Office Road (Running Hill) may be possible. **THERE IS NO EXIT TO THE A31 FROM THIS ROAD!** Diversions will be in operation during the Phase 1 closure utilising the A31, Stoney Cross Plain Road, Newtown Road, and Lyndhurst Road.

Phase 2 will be the closure of Lyndhurst Road from Seaman's Lane to Furzey Lane. Access to the Hall and Club will not be possible from the entrances to Minstead from the A31. Diversion in place during Phase 2 will utilise: A31, Stoney Cross Plain Road, Newtown Road, Lyndhurst Road, Football Green, Bull Lane and Seamans Lane.

Phase 3 will be the closure of Old Post Office Road. Therefore you would not be able to reach the Hall/ Club using this road. Diversions will be in operation using the A31, Stoney Cross Plain Road, Newtown Road, Lyndhurst Road, Football Green, Bull Lane and Seamans Lane.
