Thought for the Week

Disciples in the Prophetic Word

God still speaks today.

Bishop Tim's 3rd 'P' is for we disciples to be *prophetic* global citizens.

What does this mean?

Prophecy is 'speaking God's Words after Him'. It can take many forms:

- 1. Simply reading, or reading aloud a coherent passage of scripture which makes God's Word on a subject clear.
- 2. Applying God's revealed Word in a particular global situation, e.g. speaking up for the poor of Rwanda;
- 3. Speaking out a message of encouragement, warning, disclosure, wisdom, knowledge with which a person feels inspired.
- a) Declaring things absent to those present
 - b) Declaring a future happening

St Paul encouraged prophecy as the most helpful of all the gifts of the Spirit (*charismata*) (1Cor 14). How do we know if the 'prophecy' is actually God's Word, or simply a particular human interpretation, point of view, opinion, desire, framed in prophetic 'thus sayeth the Lord' language?

- 1. Does is accord with the settled, sifted, agreed Word in the canonical scriptures (i.e. the Bible)?
- 2. Does it bring about a growth in God's kingdom?
- 3. Does it come to pass?
- 4. If it fails any of these tests, it is not prophecy, but human invention, and therefore is not to be accepted as having authority from God.


