### **PLEASE TRY AND PROTECT OUR VERGES**

The roadside verges in and around the village are very soft and wet at the moment due to the wet winter we are having. This makes them particularly susceptible to damage. We understand that sometimes you can't avoid putting a wheel off the road, but do please try to minimise this as much as possible by thinking ahead and passing slowly and safely. It is not acceptable to park on the verges or in the entrances to closed carparks to walk dogs or feed livestock. Our verges are a precious resource, many are designated sites of scientific interest, and they can take a long time to recover from damage.
