2019 IS THE 70TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE NATIONAL PARKS

It's 70 years since the 1949 Act of Parliament that established the family of National Parks in England and Wales. Known as Britain's breathing spaces, national parks are areas of spectacular landscape which are given the highest level of protection so that everyone can visit and enjoy them.

D-DAY AND THE CANADIAN MEMORIAL AT MOGSHADE HILL

Amongst the many other D-day 75th anniversary celebrations was a Remembrance and Rededication Service at the Canadian Memorial at Mogshade Hill on Wednesday 5th June. A cross was erected here on 14th April 1944 by men of the 3rd Canadian Division of the Royal Canadian Army Service Corps who were stationed in the area during the build up to D-day.



The original two pine logs that were bolted together to form the Cross were replaced with New Forest oak in 1949 held together with the original bolt. The Cross has since been replaced again using local oak and the original bolt. On the Sunday nearest 6th June every year the New Forest Fellowship of Services holds a remembrance service at the Memorial so that future generations do not forget the Canadian presence in Hampshire in 1944.
