Volunteers will be able to sign up for shifts using the Minstead Community Shop Three Rings Volunteer Management System. A password will be sent to enable them to do this.

Volunteers will be expected to comply with the Shop's Operating Procedures which will be available to read in the shop in hard copy and also on the Filestore in Three Rings. Full training will be provided and regular updates and news will be sent out weekly or more often if necessary.
